

## Navigating the iLs Forum:

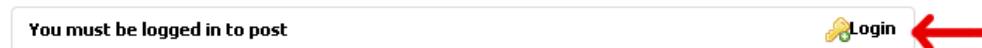
Please read the instructions all the way through once before accessing the forum.

In order to actively participate in discussions on the iLs forums *you must be logged into the website*. Without logging in, you will only be able to read the **General** section of the forum, and will not be able to post any response. Once logged in, you will be able to see, and post in, all sections of the forum. There are two ways, currently, where you can access the login page from the iLs website, illustrated below:

Logging in via either option will keep you logged into the forum as well as the professional section of the site.

Once logged in, be sure to click on the “Profile” button and change your Forum Display Name to something original. By default, your username will show up as your *email address*, which will be visible to the public, if not changed. Click “Update Profile” at the bottom of the page to save your changes.
